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Addendum - NATA Rules - Transition Statement for introduction of the Second Schedule new Mandatory Statements for facilities accredited to ISO/IEC 17025:2005

The July 2016 transition statement advised of the introduction of the following mandatory statements.

Accredited for compliance with ISO/IEC 17025 - Testing

Accredited for compliance with ISO/IEC 17025 - Calibration

This was to make it clear as to which activity (i.e. testing or calibration) the accreditation is related.

Where a facility is accredited for both conformity assessment activities, it is appropriate for a combined statement to be applied to endorsed reports e.g. Accredited for compliance with ISO/IEC 17025 - Testing/Calibration
